Analysis of Questionnaires Of a total of 400 questionnaires distributed, only 380 completed questionnaires were the base for computing the results. Four (4) questionnaires completed by those who never had the chance to attend workshops, three (3) non-responses and thirteen (13) with a lot of missing data were subtracted from the total sample size.

One must recall that Likert-type data is ordinal data, i.e. we can only say that one score is higher than another, not the distance between the points.
